Built by J. Whittaker in 1883 in a new style that was fast becoming popular (red brick with gables) and as part of the Gunter Estate. Owned by brothers James and Robert Gunter the Gunter Estate spread over a wide expansion of South West London including similar lavish properties in Old Brompton Road, Earls Court and Bolton Gardens.

C & D Restoration Limited were commissioned as Main Contractors to complete all external decorations/restorations; firstly by removing all purple paintwork that had been applied to the entire front elevations brickwork. On removing the paintwork it was discovered that the brickwork needed heavy restoration works to be undertaken. Repair and restoration works were also carried out to the stone balcony, detailed window surrounds, heads and cills.

Following a final rinse down C & D Restoration Limited then completed the project by painting all stone detailing and railings.
