Designed by George Devey and built in 1884, this beautiful Arts and Crafts house is unusually large and well laid out for a London home.

Using traditional materials and mortars C & D Restoration Limited completely restored the exterior's impressive original stone and brick features, which have been contrasted with contemporary designs to bring the house into the 21st century.

Devey's original drawings were thoroughly researched with the façade carefully restored back to its original grandeur. As a result the house is more complete than it has ever been including some feature details that were not executed when the house was originally built.

Having completed the final thorough clean of the building it was clear that the Lennox Gardens façade had been retained to the original decorative mouldings, while the Mews façades have been rebuilt to suit the new elevations and room layouts.
